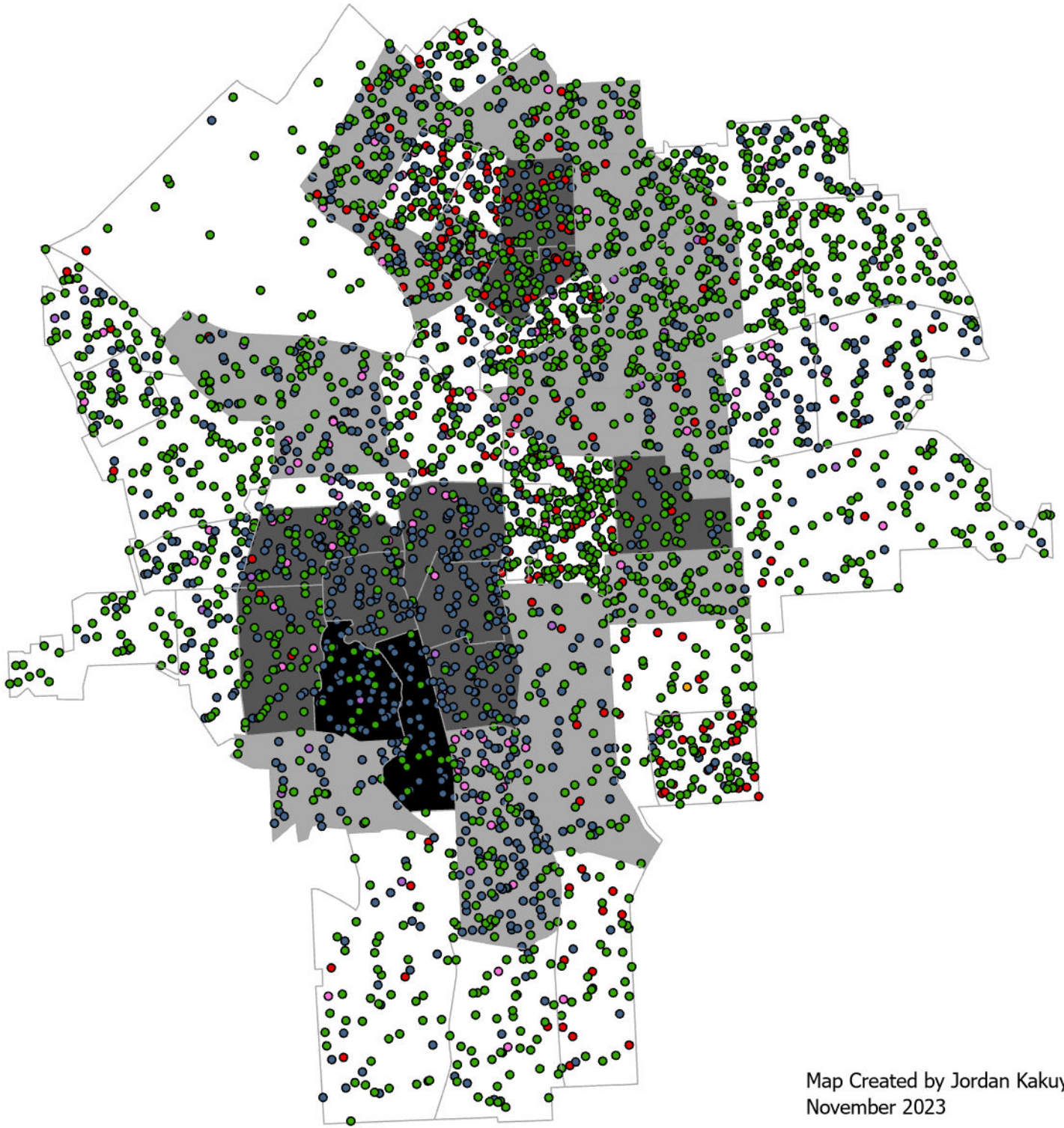


Onondaga Earth Corps Tree Planting Sites and Syracuse Racial Composition

While the basemap represents the number of trees in each census tract. Darker areas indicate more trees were planted there, while lighter areas indicate the opposite.
